

AngelSense at School A QUICK GUIDE FOR PARENTS

This quick guide will help you to introduce AngelSense to your child's school staff.

AngelSense helps schools comply with requirements to achieve extra measures that are necessary for keeping children with special needs safe.

Many schools embrace the use of AngelSense and even purchase it for students at risk.

For your child's safety, it is essential that you allow school staff access to your child's AngelSense app. They will then receive AngelSense alerts and may use the search tools. Keep in mind that school staff are on location and are therefore able to respond fastest to an emergency.

At times, there may be objections for using AngelSense at school, typically due to school regulations regarding the voice features and because school staff is not aware that these features can be disabled during school hours. Many schools are also not aware of the benefits of using AngelSense at school.

We recommend following these steps when introducing AngelSense to your child's school:

1. Send the [AngelSense School Guide](#) to your child's school staff, to introduce them to AngelSense and the different options available for schools.
2. Provide school staff with a [Letter of Medical Necessity](#) from your child's pediatrician.
